



Occasional Obstructions to the Multipurpose Path Rehabilitation of the Lachine Canal railway bridge

Date: From late May 2026 to September 2027
Mostly during the day, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.*

Location: On the railway bridge spanning the Lachine Canal

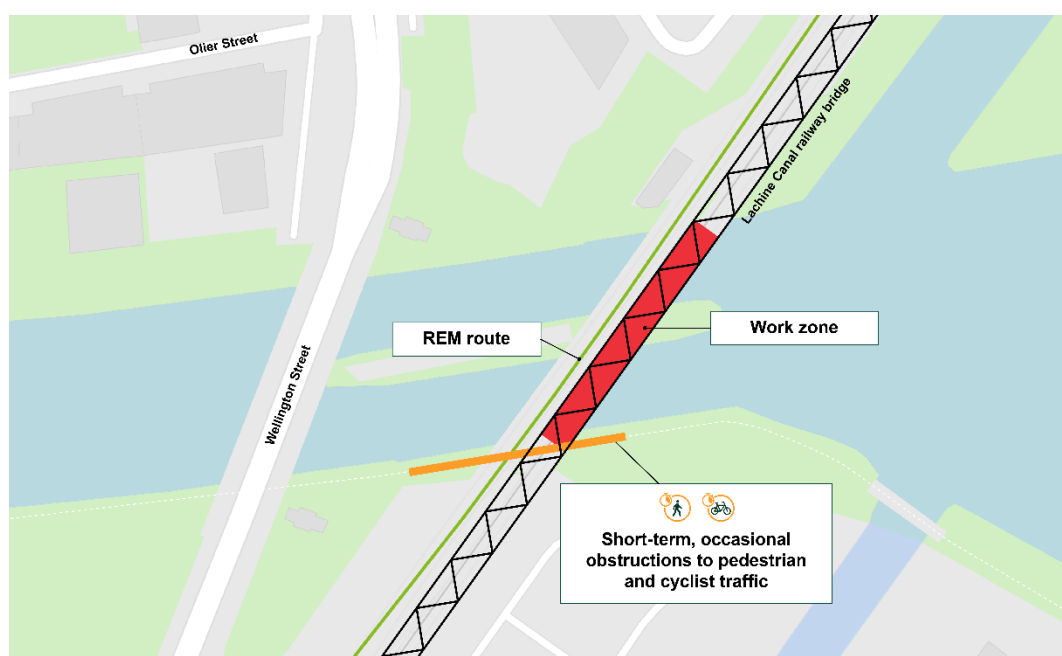
*These dates are subject to change. The work schedule runs from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Pre- and post-shift work mobilizes and de-mobilizes equipment and cleans up the site.

Description of the work:

From **late May 2026 to September 2027**, rehabilitation work on the Lachine Canal railway bridge will continue in order to secure and restore the bridge. The work is taking place on railway tracks adjacent to the REM and does not affect REM service.

During the work, the multipurpose path south of the bridge will be temporarily narrowed. On occasion, short-term closures may occur to allow equipment to be moved within the work site, under the supervision of flaggers. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will nevertheless be maintained.

Impacts and mitigations measures:

- **Noise** and **dust** may be generated by this work. Monitoring will be carried out by environmental experts, and **mitigation measures** will be implemented when required.
- **Short term, occasional obstructions** to the multipurpose path south of the bridge will be required. Flaggers will be on site to ensure the safety of path users and workers.
- **Occasional night work** will take place to allow certain activities to be carried out without disrupting rail traffic during the day.
